- ****DO NOT THROW** your trash on the ground, dumpster and trash cans have been provided
- **RIDER RELEASE MUST BE SIGNED BEFORE RIDING**
- **HELMETS REQUIRED TO RIDE A MOTORCYCLE ON THE PROPERTY**
- **No spectator motorcycles/ATVs/UTVs allowed on course during the competition (per AMA regulations)**
- Gate fee is \$10 per person (ages 10 & up), **per day**, or \$20 for entire weekend , **per person** (ages 10 & up)
- DSL internet available
- Restrooms: Bath houses and Port-a-Johns will be available
- Practice in designated areas only.
- The loop will be approximately 5 miles
- **PRO SHOOTOUT:**
- **ALL PRO** riders will ride two loops each day; after the two loops are completed, the TOP five scoring riders will compete in a shoot-out where the sections are more challenging and will determine the top five finishing positions each day.
